DESCRIPTION: Summer Snapshots is a social media campaign on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram where users upload their photos with the hashtag #NLsummer and the subject “**Summer in North Lanarkshire**”.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD: The Summer Snapshots campaign runs from the 12th of June 2019 to the 31st of July 2019.

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS: This campaign is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook, Twitter or Instagram.

1. By using the hashtag #NLsummer, participants accept that their photos may be shared by various North Lanarkshire Council’s social media profiles on Facebook, Twitter and/or Instagram.
2. The organisers are not responsible for any lost or inappropriate content with the hashtag #NLsummer.
3. Images featuring people that can be identified, including children, are not recommended, and will not be featured or shared by the organiser. Likewise, they will be discarded from the prize draw.
4. Selfies featuring only the photographer, when the photographer is an adult, could be shared by the organiser and will be considered for the prize draw.
5. Any entries received from private accounts will not be featured by the organisers due to privacy restrictions.
6. Participants agree that no obscene or inappropriate content will be submitted. Entrants are solely responsible for the information they provide and views they express on their social media accounts.
7. The organisers reserve the right to use the contents of entry submissions provided by entrants for editorial, advertising, marketing and promotional purposes, unless prohibited by law or otherwise specified in these Terms & Conditions.

PRIZE: There is a sole prize consisting of two adult tickets (16+) and two children tickets (15 or under) for the 'Beauty and the Beast' at Motherwell Concert Hall and Theatre on Sunday the 17th of November at 6pm. The prize is not interchangeable for other prizes or cash.

1. A winner will be randomly drawn among the users that have shared a photo on Facebook, Instagram or Twitter with the hashtag **#NLsummer** and the subject "**Summer in North Lanarkshire**", and whose profile is accessible for the organisers to get in touch.
2. There is no age limit or geographical boundaries to enter the prize draw; however, the following considerations should be noted:
 - a. Should the winner be under the age of 18, it will be required that contact details of a parent or guardian are provided before proceeding any further. Details on collection will only be shared with the parent or guardian once contact has been established.
 - b. Prize will not be sent or delivered to the winner. Collection at the Motherwell Concert Hall and Theatre is to be arranged by the winner with Culture NL.
8. The winner will be notified within three calendar days from the closing date of the campaign, and will be asked to provide full name, age, and contact details to be forwarded to Culture NL. If under 18, the contact details must be of a parent or guardian.
9. Should the winner fail to reply within four calendar days after being notified, the prize will be re-drawn.
10. Any entries received from private accounts will not be entered due to privacy restrictions.

Privacy statement: We only collect those personal details necessary to identify and contact the winner when applicable, and arrange prize collection. Once the competition closes and the winners are contacted, we will delete and never store nor share personal data of any individual taking part in this competition.
